**ORDER**

After hearing the parties TSPL is directed to furnish the following information by 17.04.2019 as per the annexure enclosed with this Order for the period September 2016 to September 2018 with a copy to PSPCL (through hard copy & soft copy).

1. Month wise declared availability (converted to MUs) and month wise scheduled power duly verified by SLDC.
2. Month wise Gross energy generated and month wise energy billed by TSPL.
3. Statement indicating month wise GCV of coal received from MCL and alternate sources duly authenticated by the PSPCL representative(s) deputed at plant site and TSPL representative(s).

4. Month wise ACQ which was required to be requisitioned and reasons for any less ACQ requisitioned in various months for the aforesaid period.
5. Reasons for less receipt of coal, if any, than requisitioned and date wise compilation of correspondence with MCL/CIL regarding short supply of coal and replies thereto by MCL, if any.
6. Month wise blending of 'coal received' from other sources with MCL coal.

PSPCL shall file its comments/verify the data/information submitted by TSPL as also on the details/information submitted by TSPL vide letter no. TSPL/PSERC/CN/OCT-18/256 Dated 23.10.2018 by 27.04.2019 with a copy to PSPCL. (through hard copy & soft copy).

The petition shall be taken up for hearing on 01.05.2019 at 11.00 A.M.
