- 4. Month wise ACQ which was required to be requisitioned and reasons for any less ACQ requisitioned in various months for the aforesaid period.
- 5. Reasons for less receipt of coal, if any, than requisitioned and date wise compilation of correspondence with MCL/CIL regarding short supply of coal and replies thereto by MCL, if any.
