## **ORDER**

The petition is taken up for admission. The officer representing PSPCL submits that the present petition has been filed to seek approval of the Commission to waive off interest on the amount recoverable from consumers on account of voltage surcharge in view of Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment, by relaxing the provisions of Regulation 6 of Consumer Complaint Handling Procedure (CCHP). The Commission observes that provision quoted by PSPCL is applicable in the cases decided by Dispute Settlement Committee or CGRF. The PSPCL is directed to quote the relevant provisions of law and the regulations under which the petition has been filed. PSPCL should also submit list of consumers, who are covered by the said orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court, along with the principal amount and interest thereon recoverable and deposited by each consumer as on 30.04.2019. PSPCL should also clearly indicate the total amount of interest and/or principal amount which is proposed to be waived off by PSPCL. This information be submitted within two weeks.
