ORDER

NPL having failed to give details of work in the original scheme and the enhanced scope of work in the revised scheme had requested that Rites Limited be impleaded as a party to the petition which was accepted and directions issued vide order dated 13.12.2018. Rites Limited vide letter dated 02.01.2019 has submitted that it was neither involved in the original detailed project report nor was it involved in preparation of the tender document of the work and therefore its name may be removed from the list of parties. During the hearing, the counsel for NPL submitted that they will seek the necessary clarification from Rites Limited and submit the same before the Commission and also requested for removal of the name of Rites Limited from the list of parties. The counsel for PSPCL did not oppose the same. Keeping in view the above, the name of Rites Limited as a respondent is struck off from the list of parties.

The counsel for NPL requested for some more time for submitting the clarification of information as directed by the Commission. NPL shall submit the information by 12.03.2019 with a copy to PSPCL (through hard copy & soft copy). PSPCL may reply to the information thus submitted by 30.03.2019 with a copy to NPL as well (through hard copy & soft copy).
