Corrigendum

The Commission, vide Order dated 18.09.2020, disposed of the subject cited petition as under:

...“Whereas, PSPCL as distribution licensee is concerned, the Commission after considering all the submissions, documents, explanations and arguments of PSPCL, decides to impose a penalty of Rs. One lakh on PSPCL under Section 142 of the Act for its failure for contravention of the Orders of the Commission dated 09.06.2015 in Petition No. 61 of 2014 and various provisions of the Act/Regulations.”

It has been noticed by the Commission that at page No. 20 in line No. 20 of the Order the words “its failure for” after the words “under Section 142 of the Act for” are required to be deleted. Therefore, the words “its failure for” occurring at page No. 20 in line No. 20 after the words “under Section 142 of the Act for” of the Order

dated 18.09.2020 in petition No. 17 of 2018 (Suo Motu) are deleted and the concluding para of the Order shall read as under:

“....Whereas, PSPCL as distribution licensee is concerned, the Commission after considering all the submissions, documents, explanations and arguments of PSPCL, decides to impose a penalty of Rs. One lakh on PSPCL under Section 142 of the Act for contravention of the Orders of the Commission dated 09.06.2015 in Petition No. 61 of 2014 and various provisions of the Act/Regulations.”
