**ORDER**

The petition was taken up for hearing on admission. Vide order dated 24.05.2024, PSPCL was directed to submit the details of outstanding defaulting amount of the Industries/Industries linked with Industrial Associations who have submitted the request of OTS and that PSPCL shall also submit the outstanding amount pertaining to Gram Panchayat/Rural Water Supply Schemes, Local Bodies Department and Other Govt. Departments. Govt. of Punjab was directed to submit a fresh affidavit regarding assurance of clearance of outstanding due of Govt. Departments. PSPCL has submitted its reply vide memo no. 6144 dated 31.07.2024 and Govt. of Punjab Department of Power has submitted its reply vide memo no. Power PR011/1/2023-OSD Power/69 dated 06.08.2024. After hearing the representative appearing for PSPCL, petition is admitted. The defaulting amount is pending mainly against Water Supply & Sanitation, Local Govt, Rural Development & Panchayat and Health and Family Welfare Departments which are necessary parties for the proper adjudication of this matter. The same are impleaded as respondents in the petition. Notice be issued to the respondents. The Commission would

also like a specific response from the departments of Rural Development and Panchayats and Local Govt. on the observation/specific directions of the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission to these local self Govt. bodies to use their funds to clear their electricity dues. The respondents may file reply within two weeks with a copy to PSPCL (through hard & soft copy).
