**ORDER**

Vide Order dated 11.08.2023, Petition No. 46 of 2023 filed by PSPCL and Petition No. 47 of 2023 filed by NPL were clubbed for hearing. During hearing on 11.08.2023, the Ld. counsel for PSPCL impressed upon the immediate stay of the invoice No. NPL/CD/JU/PSPCL/SEI/230602/1 raised by NPL claiming Rs. 164.14 Crores towards procurement of 2.36995 Lakhs MT of imported/alternate coal from October 2017 to March 2018. On this NPL stated that at least the principal amount be paid pending the final decision of the matter. Both the parties consented that principal amount be paid meanwhile. Accordingly, the Commission directed PSPCL to release the principal energy charges for the imported coal as raised by NPL pending the final decision in the petition. In view of the above directions of the Commission, the I.A No. 12 of 2023 stands disposed of.

NPL has filed rejoinder in Petition No. 47 of 2023 to the reply filed by PSPCL only on 31.10.2023. The Ld. Counsel for PSPCL requested for time to examine the same for arguing the matter.

The Petitions shall be taken up for hearing on admission on 10.01.2024 at 11.30 AM.
