PSTCL has filed its reply dated 20.01.2025 and the petitioner has filed rejoinder thereto on 21.01.2025. The review petitioner has pointed out in its rejoinder that considering the information submitted by PSTCL in its petition for ARR and Determination of Tariff for FY 2025-26 and True Up for FY 2023-24, the percentage loss at 400 KV system comes out to 0.27%. PSTCL shall file its reply in this regard within one week with a copy to the review petitioner. PSTCL has further submitted vide memo no. 15 dated 20.01.2025 for directions regarding finalization of methodology to be followed by SLDC for voltage wise loss calculations under SAMAST scheme.
