Review Petition under Section 64 of the PSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2005, praying for review of the order dated 27.10.2022 passed by the Commission in Petition no. 46 of 2022 vide which the petition filed by the petitioner under Regulations 44,45,46 of PSERC (Electricity Supply Code and Related Matters), Regulations, 2014, read with Regulation 69 of the PSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2005, for seeking interpretation/clarification regarding category, out of categories mentioned in explanation (b) of section 126 of the Act, under which unauthorized use of electricity as mentioned in second proviso to Regulation 36.1.3 of the PSERC (Electricity Supply Code and Related Matters) Regulations, 2014 falls because as per Annexure-8 attached with the PSERC (Electricity Supply Code and Related Matters) Regulations, 2014 the method to calculate the electricity charges in case of unauthorized use of electricity is different for each category, was dismissed.
