## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## STAFF PAPER FOR INVITING OBJECTIONS/COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC/STAKEHOLDERS ON THE PROPOSAL TIME OF DAY (ToD) TARIFF FOR LARGE SUPPLY AND MEDIUM SUPPLY INDUSTRIAL CATEGORIES OF CONSUMERS.

- 1. Peak Load Hours restrictions were imposed by erstwhile PSEB to tackle power shortage/regulation and transmission & distribution system constraints during peak load hours. However, the conditions have changed in the last few years, with Punjab becoming a power surplus State and system constraints have also been tackled due to investment in transmission and distribution system. For the past couple of years and during the processing of ARR for FY 2016-17, a view has emerged that Peak Load Exemption Charges (PLEC) should be removed completely and in its place Time of Day (ToD) tariff should be levied.
