As per Section 86 (1) (a) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (PSERC) has been assigned the function of determining the tariff for generation, supply, transmission and wheeling of electricity, wholesale, bulk or retail, as the case may be, within the State.

The Commission notes that Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (distribution licensee) is faced with a Surplus Energy situation. Proposals are invited from the interested Consulting Agencies for advising PSERC on the following policy issues for the MYT Control Period FY 2017-18 to FY 2019-20:

To suggest measures to the Commission for effectively addressing the issue of surplus energy available with PSPCL for the MYT Control Period from FY 2017-18 to FY 2019-20 and to prepare a brief study report on the following aspects:

- *i)* steps to be taken to manage the surplus power scenario for enhancing consumption
- ii) to evaluate the probability of evacuating power after improvement in the National Grid, especially to the southern States
- iii) optimum generation of power by various generating stations of Punjab and to review the purchase obligations already entered into
- *iv)* evaluate the impact of various steps taken by PSPCL for implementing the directives of PSERC to achieve better supply of electricity
- v) to suggest measures for better consumer satisfaction including better redressal of grievances by CGRF and Ombudsman

The last date for receipt of proposals is 31st of January, 2017 upto 3.00 PM.
