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PUBLIC NOTICE

Everest Power Private Ltd.(EPPL) has filed a petition (54 of 2012; [Click here for petition](#)) in the Commission under section 62 (2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 56(2), (3) and (4) of the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2005 for determination of Tariff for supply of power to Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. (PSPCL) from 100MW (2x50MW) Malana II Hydro Electric Project set up in the state of Himachal Pradesh. Proposals are invited from interested Consulting Agencies having sufficient and relevant experience and expertise to assist the Commission, in the vetting of the Capital Cost of the Project and calculation of various components of tariff etc., as per CERC/Commission's Guidelines/ Regulations available on CERC/ PSERC's websites respectively. The bids should include details of (i) consultancy charges in one quote including travel, stay, office expenses or any other sundry charges including all tax liability under income tax, service tax, professional tax and any other tax existing or likely to be imposed (ii) firm's experience (iii) qualifications and relevant experience of individual team members who would be associated with the job (iv) timeframe for completing the job (90 days maximum) and (v) other relevant details. The vetting will include time and cost overrun during the execution of the Project 'attributable' and 'not attributable' to the generating company along with reasons for the same. The bids are required to be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes marked (a) technical bid, comprising details at (ii) to (v) above and (b) financial bid, comprising consultancy charges as per (i) above. Both these envelopes should be duly enclosed in a single sealed envelope superscribed "Bids for vetting of capital cost of 100 MW Malana II HEP". The selected bidder will be required to submit a sworn affidavit that it has no business/commercial/legal relationship of any kind whatsoever, with the petitioner/respondent(s) (EPPL, PSPCL, PTC India Ltd.) and also execute a contract in line with the provision(s) in the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Engagement of Consultants)

Regulations, 2012. The payment will be made after the successful completion of the job to the satisfaction of the Commission.

The bids should be submitted with the 'Earnest Money' in the shape of Demand Draft of value Rs. 50000/- (Rs. Fifty thousand only) in favour of Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission, payable at Chandigarh. The bid documents shall be submitted in the Commission's office before 1500 Hrs. on 04.02.2013 and Technical bids shall be opened on the same day at 1600 Hrs. The Financial bids of only those bidders shall be opened at 1500 Hrs. on 18.02.2013, who qualify as per the criteria decided by the Commission for evaluation of the technical bids detailed at Annexure – I. Representative(s) of the bidders, who wish to be present, may attend the opening of technical / financial bids. PSERC may at its discretion, extend the due date and time for submission of the bids. Bids received without requisite earnest money or after the due date and time shall not be considered. PSERC reserves the right to reject any/all bid(s) without assigning any reason.
