As per existing General Conditions of Tariff, all the Large Supply Industrial Consumers and Medium Supply Industrial Consumers having sanctioned load of 50 kW or more are subjected to Peak Load Hour Restrictions. During restriction period, the consumers are allowed to use part of their load subject to fulfilling the basic conditions as laid down by the distribution licensee (PSPCL) with the approval of the Commission and paying Peak Load Exemption Charges (PLEC). The Commission proposes to discontinue the practice of seeking Peak Load Exemption and replacing it with Time of Day (ToD) Tariff. Further, the Commission also purposes to introduce Contract Demand System in case of Medium Supply Industrial Consumers.
