INVITATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE POST OF OMBUDSMAN.

1. the Punjab State Regulatory Commission which is a body corporate under Section 82 of the Electricity Act,2003, invites applications from interested eligible persons for selection to the post of Ombudsman.
2. The Ombudsman shall consider and decide the representation of the consumers against non-redressal of their grievances as envisaged under sub-section(6) and (7) of Section 42 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with “PSERC” (Forum and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2005 and shall also carry out any other functions duties entrusted to him under the provisions of PSERC (Forum and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2005.
3. In order to be eligible for consideration of appointment as Ombudsman, the applicant should be a person of ability, integrity and standing having adequate knowledge of and proven capacity in dealing with problems relating to engineering, finance, commerce, economics, law or management. He should also have working knowledge of Punjabi.
4. The appointment shall be for a period of three years which may be extended by the Commission upto a maximum of five years. Further no person shall be appointed or continued in his appointment as such if he/she has reached the age of seventy years.
5. The Ombudsman shall be paid remuneration as may be determined by the Commission. Ombudsman shall also be entitled to office facilities, casual leave/extra ordinary leave and TA/DA as admissible to Grade-I officers of the State Government.
6. The office of Ombudsman is located at SAS Nagar, Mohali.

7. The interested persons may send their applications with the following bio-data to the Secretary, Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission, SCO No.220-221, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh, latest by 12.06.2014:-
 - a) Name
 - b) Age & Date of Birth
 - c) Present assignment, if any
 - d) Educational Qualification
 - e) Whether the candidate possesses working knowledge of Punjabi.
 - f) Details of posts previously held and experience.
 - g) Experience/knowledge of power sector in Punjab and/or other States/Centre.
 - h) Familiarity with the consumer affairs and arbitration matters.
 - i) Details of association with non-governmental organization
 - j) Any other relevant information
8. In case the interested person is already in service, he should furnish an undertaking from his employer to the effect that he will be relieved from service in the event of his being selected for nomination.
9. The envelop containing application may be superscribed as "Application for Ombudsman".
10. The decision of the Commission in all matters would be final and binding and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
