

**VACANCY CIRCULAR**

Applications are invited for filling up three posts of Deputy Director/Technical in the pay scale of Rs.16650-39100+8500 GP, one post of Deputy Director/Monitoring & Finance in the pay scale of Rs.16650-39100+8500 GP and one post of Superintendent Grade-1 in the pay scale of Rs.10900-34800+5750 GP from serving/retired officers of Central/State Government or PSUs under Central/State Govt. on deputation/contract basis.

1. **Qualification and Experience**

I. **Deputy Director/Technical (3 No.)**

(a) **Minimum Educational Qualifications:**

Degree in Electrical/Mechanical/Electronics & Communication Engineering.

(b) **Qualifying service:**

- (i) Serving/retired officers of the Central/State Government or PSU under State/Central Government must have experience of working on the post in the scale of Rs.15600-39100 +Rs.7600 GP

**Or**

Minimum 10 years experience of working on the post in the scale of Rs.15600-39100+5400/- Grade Pay.

**Or**

- (ii) Minimum ten years experience of working in power sector out of which minimum of two years experience relating to power distribution, regulatory/commercial matters and tariff setting in a large scale power utility.

(c) **Nature of experience**

Familiarity with Electricity laws, regulatory affairs and latest techno-commercial development in the power sector. Preference shall be given to candidates with exposure in matters relating to techno-economic appraisal

of power projects / schemes, tariff setting, demand side management, power system planning and operation and other activities relevant to the working of the Commission.

- (d) Working knowledge of Computer .
- (e) Matric pass in Punjabi language.

## **II. Deputy Director/Monitoring & Finance (1 No.)**

### **(a) Minimum Educational Qualification**

CA/ICWA/CFA/CPA or MBA in Finance

**Or**

Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university and should have passed Sectional Officer Grade examination conducted by CAG of India or SAS examination conducted by the State Government/PSPCL or similar entities.

### **(b) Qualifying service:**

- (i) Serving/Retired Officers of the Central/State Government or PSU under State/Central Government must have experience of working on the post in the scale of Rs.15600-39100 +Rs.7600 GP

**Or**

With 5 years regular service in the pay band of Rs.15600-39100+Rs.6600 Grade Pay

**Or**

- (ii) Minimum ten years experience of working in power sector out of which minimum of two years experience relating to Power Distribution, commercial matters, financial management and Tariff Setting in a large scale power utility.

### **(c) Nature of Experience**

Having knowledge of State/ Central Government accounting procedure, Tariff formulation or cost analysis or financial management.

- (d) Working knowledge of Computer.
- (e) Matric pass in Punjabi language.

### **III. Superintendent Grade-1 ( 1 No.)**

(a) **Minimum Educational Qualifications:**

Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university and should have passed Ministerial Accounts Examination/Senior Assistant Accounts Examination conducted by the State Government/PSPCL or similar entities;

(b) **Qualifying service:**

Serving/retired officers of the Central /State Government or PSU under State /Central Government must have experience of working on the post of Superintendent Grade-1 /equivalent post

Or

Minimum two years regular service as Supdt.Gr-II /equivalent post.

(c) **Nature of Experience:**

Minimum of five years experience in establishment and service matters at secretariat level.

- (d) Working knowledge of computer
- (e) Matric pass in Punjabi language.

## 2. **Pay and Allowances**

- (i) In the case of deputationists; they shall continue to draw the pay scale of their parent departments plus deputation allowance. The employees on deputation will be entitled to draw all admissible allowances at such rates and subject to such conditions as may be applicable to the employees of the parent department or as mutually agreed between the Commission and the parent department.

- (ii) Those appointed on contract will be entitled to draw emoluments as decided by the Commission.
  - (iii) Officers who have retired from higher posts can also apply for these posts.
- 3. Those applying on contract basis should be less than 65 years of age as on 30.09.2014.
- 4. Appointment shall be initially for a period of one year which would be extendable.
- 5. Applications should be submitted to the undersigned upto 31.10.2014. Serving employees should submit their applications through proper channel with an advance copy to the Commission within specified period.
